YEARS OF POSSIBILITY

It takes a lot of **horsepower** to run our programs for over three decades! Founded in 1989, EQUI-KIDS has grown from one horse and four riders into a nationally recognized, premier accredited therapeutic riding center. In 2025, we expanded our capacity and outreach to serve more than **800** participants across our **9** core programs and provided over **4,000** hours of equine-assisted services.

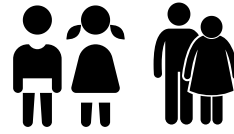
Educational and workforce initiatives helped students achieve measurable gains in communication, confidence, SOL readiness, and STEAM concepts through our School Partnership and Job Coaching programs. Through over **3,500** therapeutic sessions, we strengthened volunteer engagement and herd sustainability while reducing wait times for individuals with disabilities and neurodivergent learners.

Through over **40** community partnerships and **6,000** meaningful engagements, we are proud to have kept our number one priority—**access to services**—at the forefront of our mission in 2025.

PROGRAM IMPACT

EQUI-KIDS served a diverse and growing population of kids, adults, and service members with disabilities across Hampton Roads. Of the individuals served, 76% were children and youth, while 24% were veterans and first responders, demonstrating our continued commitment to inclusive healing for all who can benefit from equine-assisted services.

100% of participants have a documented disabling condition. The rhythmic movement and responsive feedback of the horses richly connect with neurodivergent learners, bridging the gap between clinic-based therapies and inclusive recreation.

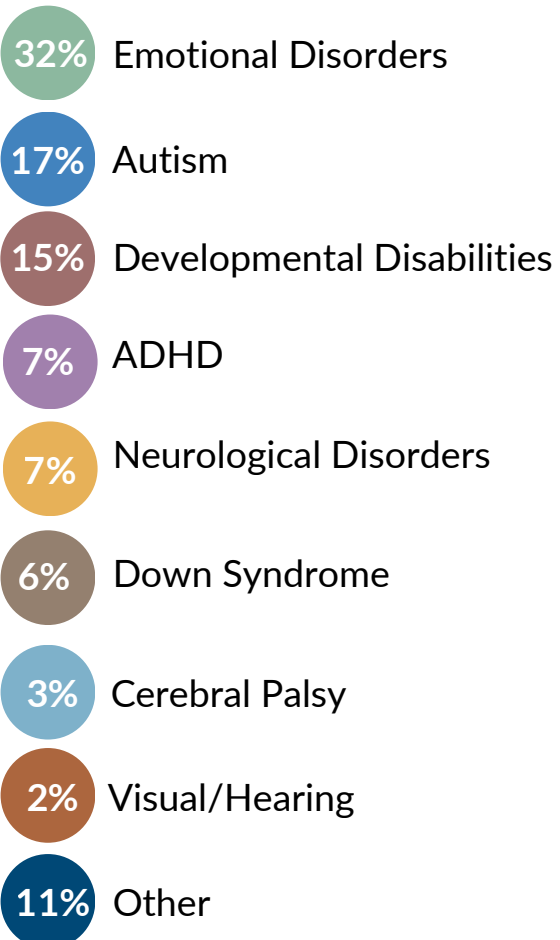

Our ADA-compliant, 92-acre facility is designed to support individuals of all abilities. The campus features adaptive equipment, accessible mounting areas, quiet spaces, and 50+ acres of wooded riding trails.

In 2025, EQUI-KIDS achieved a **100% compliance score** on our reaccreditation from the Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship (PATH) Intl., the global leader in accreditation for professional equine-assisted services.

SPECIAL ABILITIES



OUR PROGRAMS

THERAPEUTIC RIDING & HORSEMANSHIP

Adaptive riding and horsemanship lessons engage participants in individualized goals that improve posture, coordination, confidence, and communication.

HIPPOTHERAPY-SPEECH, PHYSICAL, & OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Conducted by licensed clinicians, these services use the horse's three-dimensional gait to stimulate neuromotor development, improving speech, balance, and sensory integration.

EQUINE-ASSISTED PSYCHOTHERAPY (EAP)

Delivered in partnership with licensed mental-health professionals, EAP supports youth, adults, veterans, and first responders managing conditions such as trauma and depression. Participants experienced reduced stress and anxiety and increased emotional regulation and confidence as a result of their equine-assisted sessions.

EQUI-VETS AND EQUI-HEROES

We serve veterans and first responders referred through organizations such as the VA Medical Center, Naval Medical Center Portsmouth, and the Virginia Beach Mounted Patrol, among others. Individuals reported increased confidence, reduced anxiety and PTSD, and stronger family connections as a result of their participation. In honor of their service, EQUI-VETS and EQUI-HEROES are served at no cost.

SCHOOL PARTNERSHIP & JOB COACHING PROGRAMS

In collaboration with Virginia Beach City Public Schools, students with disabilities receive experiential, STEAM-based learning that reinforces IEP goals through real-world tasks in horsemanship, animal care, and environmental science. Participants achieved measurable gains in communication, task sequencing, and workplace readiness skills.

EQUINE-ASSISTED LEARNING (EAL)

Group-based developmental programs strengthened teamwork, confidence, and self-advocacy in neurodivergent learners. EAL participants demonstrated improvement in task sequencing, focus, and regulation.

INCLUSION CAMPS & COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Adaptive summer camps and outreach events provide inclusive recreational access for youth with or without a diagnosis or special ability.

VOLUNTEERS

Volunteers remain the anchor of every lesson, event, and barn activity and play a critical role in delivering equine-assisted lessons, including therapeutic riding, hippotherapy, and equine-assisted learning. Their contributions were central to reducing the waitlist, sustaining care of the herd, and expanding outreach to new community partners in 2025.

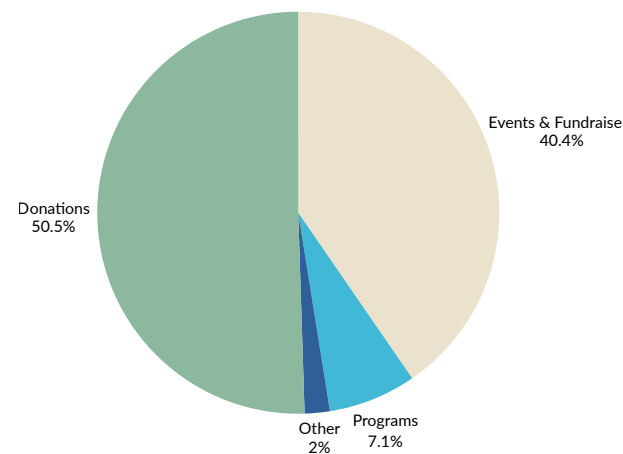
In 2025, **100% of participants** received full or partial financial assistance. All participants were physician-referred with documented diagnoses, ensuring medically appropriate and goal-aligned care.

Of the \$1.6 million it takes to run the program annually, 92% of funding comes from charitable giving and philanthropy. That's why **every donation makes a direct impact** on those we serve.

EQUI-KIDS reflects the heart of Hampton Roads: diverse, resilient, and united by the transformative power of the horse-human bond. Together, we create a community where every participant, regardless of age or ability, can learn, grow, and heal.

REVENUE

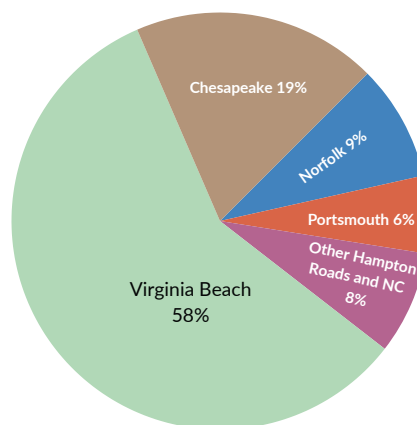


PARTICIPANT POPULATION

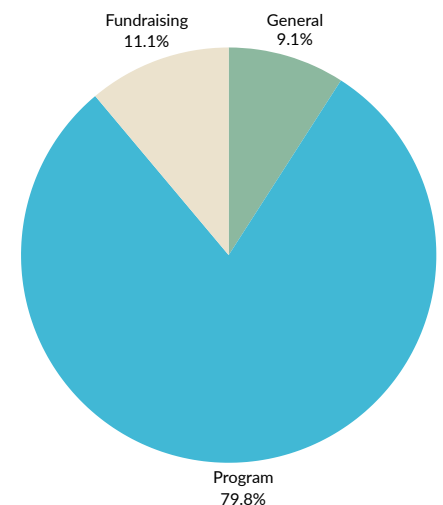

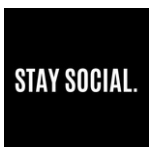
